John Aitchison joined the Liberal Party of South Africa (LPSA) in 1963 in his second year of studies at the University of Natal, where he was studying theology. He played an active role in the Liberal Party as well as the National Union of South African Students (NUSAS). He was active in exposing the forced removal of black people from freehold land they owned and after the banning of the National Chairperson of the Liberal Party in mid 1964 played a central role, as the Secretary of the Party in Natal together with organisers such as Christopher Shabalala and Mike Ndlovu, in keeping the Party active in rural areas of Natal in spite of severe government repression. He was banned in May 1965 and after a brief period after his release in mid 1970, banned again for another five years from 1971 to 1976.

After 1976 he worked in a number of distance education and adult education programmes including the SACHED Trust, Theological Education by Extension College, and he has lectured in Theology and Biblical Studies at the Federal Theological Seminary and the University of Natal. He is an ordained deacon in the Church of the Province of Southern Africa and worked as an Education Officer for the Diocese of Natal from 1979 to 1981. He also worked with an independent film production company.

In April 1981 he joined the University of Natal's Centre for Adult Education (CAE), of which he became Director in 1992. He became head of the School of Education, Training and Development (incorporating the CAE) from 1999 to 2002. Currently he is Professor of Adult Education in this School. He has played a significant role in adult education in South Africa, particularly in developing adult education and adult basic education policy at both national and provincial levels. Among the projects he has been involved in at the CAE are training courses for adult educators at certificate and post-graduate diploma levels, initiation of academic support programmes for disadvantaged students, an adult basic education newspaper supplement with circulation of 55 thousand copies in the Natal Midlands and research projects into farm schools, school dropouts, non-formal education and adult basic education.
