

## PC 16: PETER BROWN COLLECTION

Peter McKenzie Brown was a founder member of the South African Liberal Party in 1953. This was the only South African political party to have been publicly and jointly launched by people of all races. It was forced to close down by the apartheid government in 1968. PMB was National Chairman in 1960, which led to his detention without trial, and to his banning from 1964-1974. He was editor of the journal *Liberal Opinion* in the 1950s, and of *Reality: a journal of liberal and radical opinion* after 1974.

He studied Agriculture and Native Law & Administration, and has farmed in the KZN Midlands for many years. He was involved in organisations concerned with the redistribution of land. From 1974 he was involved with the Church Agricultural Project (CAP) (later known as CAP Farm Trust), and from 1979 as a co-founder of the Association for Rural Advancement (AFRA). He was also involved in the Five Freedoms Forum (FFF) and the Pietermaritzburg Dependents' Conference, which assisted the families of political prisoners. He was a member of the Liberal Democratic Association (LDA). He played a role in the establishment of the Alan Paton Centre (APC), as an old friend and colleague of Alan Paton. He was on the board of Kings' School, Nottingham Road, and the Farm Advisory Committee of the Midlands Community College in Nottingham Road.
